The Vehicle Project would upgrade or add 6 vehicles or pieces of maintenance equipment at the Alaska Zoo.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Replace Vehicles Project would upgrade the Alaska Zoo fleet of work and visitor/outreach vehicles. This would provide a total of 6 vehicles and/or pieces of equipment that would greatly expand our capabilities to maintain our facilities and provide services. The work equipment includes a new-used dump truck, a 4x4 with a bed, a track hoe and a zoom boom. The vehicles for visitors would be a new 15-passenger van and or shuttle. The outreach vehicle we are seeking is a mid-size SUV or mini-van.

Equipment Vehicles

Dump Truck: \$35,000.00

Our 1982 dump truck with its 1977 hydraulics has served us well but, it is time to replace it. A complete overhaul of the vehicle is estimated at \$32,000.00, a used replacement vehicle is estimated at \$35,000.00. We would like to purchase a used replacement. We use our dump truck about once or twice a week, so we don't feel it is necessary to purchase a brand new truck but, we'd like one around ten years old. There is no getting around needing one.

4-Wheeler with Bed: \$9,000.00

A 4-wheeler would give us the capability to haul equipment and materials throughout the 25 acre zoo year round. We could really utilize a 4-wheeler as they are small, rugged and can navigate our trails any time of year. We are forever moving equipment, tools and materials around the zoo and this would facilitate those constant needs greatly.

Track Hoe: \$43,000.00

A track hoe or mini-excavator would save the Alaska Zoo a great deal of time and money. We are constantly digging post holes for fences and signs, ditches and trenches for burying lines and just generally moving dirt and gravel. Currently, when

we have to dig post holes or trenches, we either do it by hand or schedule for a vendor to do it. It would save us hundreds of man hours if we had the equipment on hand as well as valuable construction time and money. If we hire a vendor to provide the service, we have to schedule it for when they have time. This can easily add a month delay to completing a project to an already short window of opportunity.

Zoom Boom (forklift- 2011 JLG G5-18A Tele-handler): \$98,000.00

A zoom boom forklift is a versatile piece of equipment that could be used around the entire zoo. It is difficult to find equipment that can navigate all around the zoo and has the ability to handle the weights we need to move and pick up. This forklift can move 5500 pounds and reach 18 feet vertically and 10 feet forward. It would increase our ability to move heavy and awkward materials and be able to reach and work at the high habitat fences, tree heights and roof lines of zoo buildings. Currently, we have to schedule our maintenance and improvements based on contractors' ability to provide the equipment.

New Shuttle/Passenger Van: \$40,000.00

We already provide and staff a free summer shuttle to the Alaska Zoo from downtown. It is a very popular service as there is no city bus service to the Alaska Zoo. There was such a high demand when the cruise ships arrived in Anchorage; we had to rent an additional vehicle to accommodate visitors this past summer when the ships were in town. We would like to purchase a new, 15-passenger van and add a graphic treatment. The van is estimated at \$35,300 with a graphic wrap costing \$4,300. This would serve two purposes – it would provide an additional shuttle and allow us to have at least one shuttle on the road if our current shuttle breaks down.

Education Outreach "ZOOmobile" Vehicle: \$43,000 with graphic wrap

Our current 1992 Dodge rear wheel van needs replacing. This is the vehicle we use for our outreach programs which transport animals, staff and educational materials to schools, senior homes and other community agencies. Our outreach program serves as an extension of the Alaska Zoo in the community and surrounding areas. In 2009, we provided 69 separate programs in the community serving more than 3660 participants. We are finding that as school field trips cost rise, there is more interest in our providing services directly to schools. We would like to be able to respond to the increase interest but we need a more reliable and safe vehicle. We would like to purchase an all-wheel drive vehicle that has the capability to handle a variety of sizes of animal carriers. Current estimates come in at \$35-40,000. We would like it to be graphically wrapped which we estimate at \$4,300.



The Alaska Zoo is proud of its 41 year history of providing continued service to the wildlife, people and visitors of Alaska. We are home to more than 53 different species of animals representing the largest collection of Alaskan animals in the State. We work closely with state and federal wildlife agencies. We partner with dozens of community organizations, agencies and school districts to provide services throughout the state. We are one of the top tourist destinations in the state. In 2009, more than 158,000 people visited the Alaska Zoo. In 2010, more than 161, 000 people attended the zoo.

We do this without receiving any operational funding from any municipal, state or federal entity. We work hard to raise the more than \$2 million dollars it costs to operate the zoo each year through admissions, rentals, programs and donations.

While we manage to meet our operations budget, we do seek help for capital projects. We do our best to raise funds through foundation grants and corporate/public donations; we can't get our arms around capital projects on our own.

We are seeking the State's help with a Vehicle Addition/Replacement Project which comes in at \$268,000.

The Vehicles Project would upgrade the Alaska Zoo fleet of work and visitor/outreach vehicles. This would provide a total of 6 vehicles and or pieces of equipment that would greatly expand our capabilities to maintain our facilities and provide services.
