# Senior Citizens of Kodiak, Inc. - Senior Home Meal Delivery Van Purchase

**Brief Project Description:**

These funds will be used to replace the home delivered meals vehicle, which provides nearly 10,000 meals to more than 160 seniors per year.

SCOK has \$5,000 in their current budget to match state funds.

**Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

Senior Citizens of Kodiak, Inc. (SCOK), the only senior center in the State that has been nationally accredited twice, has been providing home delivered meals to Kodiak residents 60 and older since 1973.

SCOK may be the only senior center in the State that has home delivered meals 7 days a week including holidays. For seniors who cannot shop or cook for themselves, having a hot, nutritious meal is one of the first steps in receiving home and community services which are instrumental in keeping seniors at home and their community. We know that having a hot, nutritious meal each day is vital in a senior's well-being and health. SCOK delivers meals in microwavable containers that can go from the freezer or refrigerator directly into the microwave. Containers are then picked up each day and sanitized at the senior center.

In 1973 when home delivered and congregate meal service began, the home delivered meals were few. As the Alaska senior population continues to be the fastest growing senior population in the country and within that population those being 75 and older being the fastest segment of growth, home delivered meals and the number of people receiving them has more than doubled in the last decade.

Last fiscal year, SCOK delivered 9,600 home delivered meals to 165 seniors. This includes meals delivered to the island's six village seniors as well. SCOK has collaborated with the Kodiak Area Native Association (KANA) to assure congregate as well as home delivered meals are available to village seniors for more than 10 years. The many seniors receiving home delivered meals are representative of 10% of Kodiak's total senior population. The number of people who receive home

delivered meals has grown fivefold in the last five years with the total number of home delivered meals increasing by a third.

The SCOK vehicle which is used to deliver home delivered meals is a 2003 Chrysler mini-van which has worn out its life. The stop and go use of such a vehicle makes for double the wear and tear on a normally used vehicle. SCOK is requesting \$25,600 in capital funds to replace this van. The total cost from Kodiak Motors for the vehicle is \$30,600 and SCOK has \$5,000 to match legislative capital funding to purchase this much needed replacement vehicle.
