Because there was not a system in place to communicate between schools or between principals and classrooms the evacuation took an unacceptable amount of time.

In the event of an actual emergency; fire, tsunami, bomb or lockdown this communication system the community is asking for is essential to the safety and lives of the students of Craig Schools.

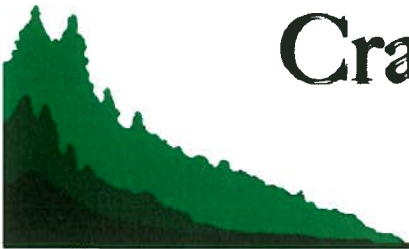


WHEREAS, none of the middle, elementary or alternative school buildings have intercom systems or any way to communicate to all rooms simultaneously in the case of an emergency, and

NOW BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of the Craig City School District that the attainment of an Emergency Communications/Telephone System is a priority of the District.

Dear Greg:

During the recent bomb scare at the Craig Schools, it became apparent that the school district needs to improve the capability to notify all of the teachers and their students in the event of an emergency. In an emergency situation where immediate evacuation is critical, it is sorely inadequate to run from classroom to classroom to spread the word about the nature of an emergency. As I understand it, there is currently no equipment in place to convey a message from one classroom to the next, or to convey a message from the front office to a specific classroom. In addition, in the recent emergency, there was no means to make emergency contact among the three campuses within the school district other than placing a phone call.

The fire alarm system that is in place is adequate to evacuate the buildings but, for example, if the students need to exit the building to the west, or if the students need to grab a coat on the way to the door in order to go home for the day, that message cannot be conveyed with the equipment currently installed.

I support your efforts to upgrade the emergency response equipment at the Craig City School District. Please let me know if there is anyway I can assist you in enhancing the safety of the school district staff and students.
