Centennial Hall Roof Replacement/Emergency Generator – This project will provide partial funding to replace the 25 year-old roof on Centennial Hall and install an emergency generator.

Centennial Hall not only provides the venue for many large public events - from meetings to inaugurations - but also functions as the largest designated disaster shelter in Southeast Alaska, serving all Southeast communities in the event of a major disaster. Centennial provides shelter for local emergencies from avalanches to cruise ship incidents.

In 2009, Jensen Yorba Lott assessed the roof's condition and determined it needs replacement. The facility also needs electrical improvements to increase its ability to function as an emergency relief center, in the event of disruption to the local electrical grid. A new roof would be constructed to significantly improve the energy efficiency and R-value of the facility. Estimated cost of the project is \$1,300,000.

As part of this request, CBJ is also asking for an additional \$1,200,000 to buy and install an emergency backup generator to support emergency shelter operations during extended power outages.

The Assembly determined this project to be one of its top ten priority Capital Improvement projects.
