Detailed Project Description and Justification:

This grant funding will provide for the replacement of two AFD command response vehicles operating with 100,000 miles each. Command response vehicles are used by Battalion Chiefs to respond to complex emergencies, where they provide incident command, safety and supervisory oversight of crews. Command response vehicles are also used to transport life-safety equipment and tools between emergency scenes and public safety facilities.

The estimated cost is \$70,000 per vehicle which includes emergency lights, radio, mobile computer, and modifications necessary to safely carry air bottles and other equipment.
