## Chenega IRA Council Resolution 11-2

A resolution authorizing Chugach School District to seek funding from the Alaska State Legislature in the amount of \$906,841 for the construction of a new teacher duplex housing unit in Chenega Bay, Alaska

- WHEREAS the Chenega IRA Council (hereinafter "Tribe" is a federally recognized tribe; and
- WHEREAS the Chenega IRA Council is the governing body of the Tribe; and
- WHEREAS the Tribe is seeking to assist the Chugach School District in attracting quality teachers to Chenega Bay for the school there; and
- WHEREAS the Tribe has documented the priorities of the local community to provide quality education for the children of Chenega Bay; and
- WHEREAS the Tribe agrees that the present school housing is becoming uninhabitable and requires totally new construction; and
- WHEREAS the Tribe agrees that finding qualified teachers willing to live in rural Alaska will require providing adequate housing in order to keep teachers and their families in the village of Chenega Bay.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Chenega IRA Council hereby authorizes a legislative appropriations request to the State of Alaska for funding of new teacher housing construction in the Native Village of Chenega Bay.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chenega IRA Council authorizes that its Chairman shall have full authority to negotiate, execute and administer grant funds or contract for such benefits to our village.
