The repair and resurfacing of the tennis courts would include:

- courts cleaning, level low spots, repair of cracks,4 coats of Plexipave with game lines.....\$ 58,800.00 per 6 courts
- new equipment package (nets posts).....\$ 4,200.00 per 6 courts
- remove old posts, reset ground sleeves, center anchors\$ 12,000.00 per 6 courts

Justification:
 Existing cracks and low (holding water) spots could result in the injuries of the players. Aside from the need to ensure safety for children and adults, resurfacing now will be less expensive than waiting when the cracks have become larger and more costly to repair. Fairbanks Tennis Association has been a partner with Fairbanks North Star Borough Parks and Recreation Dept. since 1995 and will continue their partnership in the future. The community courts provide an inexpensive sport for all family members and thousands of Fairbanks and North Pole residents benefit from the programs offered by Fairbanks Tennis Association.
