Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The current heating system in the ANB hall is outdated and requires maintenance to be done everytime the building is to be used for community activities. The ANB hall is used for all community functions and oil has to be purchased which can run in the amount of \$600 per fill of the oil tank. If a wood fired boiler was installed the community members would have access to fuel to heat the building as Angoon is surrounded by timber.

This includes a roofed building with a cement pad under the boiler. Pipe/tubing would also need to be purchased and run underneath the floor, 3/4" pipe tubing - 1000' @ \$1/foot. Labor would be local with estimate at \$12,000.
