Replace High School gymnasium floor originally installed in 1970 with a modern cushioned wood floor to prevent injuries.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

If funded, this project would replace the Haines High School Gymnasium wood floor with a new modern floor with better cushioning underneath. The current wood floor was installed when the original building was constructed in the early 1970s. It is wearing out and has developed many dents and dead spots. Its underlayment has also hardened so that the floor has very little cushioning. This makes it tougher on the knees of students running and jumping on it during PE and afterschool extracurricular activities such as volleyball and basketball. The danger of concussions is also heightened on floors without good cushioning. A modern rubber-cushioned wood floor should decrease those hazards.

Project Timeline:

If funded, we would try to get this project completed by the fall of 2011 so it would be available for student use during the 2011/12 school session.
