Egegik - Dock Repair

Brief Project Description:

The project is to replace the existing fender piling system in front of the Egegik City Dock.

*Funding Details:**The Alaska Municipal League/Joint Insurance Association has agreed to pay 1/3 of the repair costs (\$80,000); Local Funding \$70,000***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

The Egegik City Dock was constructed with a system of fender pilings placed in front of the dock. These pilings are 12" diameter steel and are structurally independent of the dock. The fender pilings are designed to protect the dock: they are driven into the river bed and connected to the dock by a series of chains. The fender piling system has been significantly damaged by ice and barges. Many of the pilings have broken away from the walers and three sections of pilings have shifted down river. Some steel structures have ladders and have been broken and the use of the ladders is now impossible.

Several of the chains that hold the walers (top of the pilings) in place have snapped and the pilings have pulled away from the dock. As a result of the damage, the structural integrity of the fender piling system has been reduced significantly and now poses a significant safety risk as well as the potential for damage to the dock itself.

The project cost is an estimate at this time. Madsen, Kneppers and Associates is currently working on a design for the repairs, a scope of work and a cost estimate.

Project Timeline:

It is hoped that the work can be completed this summer/fall after the salmon fishing season but it may be delayed until next summer depending on the timing of the funding approval, contractor and materials availability, and the limited barge delivery schedule and the corresponding shipping deadlines.
