Below is a rough breakdown of some items you might be interested in:

**1.Fire/EMS Apparatus Computers - \$7,000 per computer**

These computers are used for 911 call mapping during emergency responses along with obtaining pertinent information while enroute to calls. These computers have Pre-Fire Plans within the systems allowing the officers to view floor plan before entering structures and and recognize potential hazards within the structure before emergency crews enter.

**2.Software Update - \$100,000**

This upgrade would bring our existing system up to a level that would allow us to streamline our operating system eliminating some steps taken now. We currently use two separate computer units to gain information regarding addresses on emergency calls and this upgrade would allow all information to be obtained through one computer console.
