Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Muldoon Road/Glenn Highway Interchange has become increasingly dangerous and congested with traffic from the new shopping structure at Tikahtnu Commons. Semi-trailer trucks servicing the hospital and shopping mall now have to exit the Glenn and cross this to reach their destination. Traffic backs up onto the Highway. Students dart across rather than use the tunnel and traffic off the Glenn makes illegal left turns to reach the shops. A study into how to fix the interchange is needed from the Department of Transportation to make sense of the traffic patterns and come up with new fixes.
