You called today requesting information about the Haines Maintenance Facility. I have spoken to Rep. Thomas a few times about the desire to relocate this facility.

He has recommended a specific site nearby that includes a shop building and some acreage.

The department has not investigated in detail the ability of this facility to accommodate our needs, however, there has been anecdotal discussion indicating that the shop building is too small and would need added on to. Due to lack of funds and budget constraints, the department has not requested any funds to re-locate the existing facility.

We recognize the dilapidated condition of the existing facility and would certainly appreciate any consideration of funding a move to an acceptable location with acceptable facilities.
