Some years ago, the state provided funds to rebuild the transmission line between the Daves Creek Substation near Cooper Landing and the City of Seward. However, the funding ran out before the final section of line was replaced.

A project to upgrade the transmission line from the Daves Creek Substation near Cooper Landing to the Fort Raymond Substation in Seward was started several years ago. This transmission line serves around 5,000 meters comprised of residential, small & large businesses and state facilities. The project is not complete, but within sixteen structures of Fort Raymond Substation. This project will complete that segment. The City of Seward is the beneficiary.
