Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Long Range Transportation Plan for the Chugiak-Eagle River area identified the need for an Eagle River Central Business District and Residential Core Circulation Study. The existing transportation system creates barriers for access, circulation, and increased congestion within the downtown corridor. The challenges are expected to continue as the population increase. The Study findings identified the Artillery Road, Eagle River Road and the Old Glenn Highway Interchange as a level of high importance for upgrade and improvement. The Study recommends rebuilding and increasing the space of the interchange to alleviate congestion, traffic weaving and reduce accidents. Additional land will need to be acquired for construction of the interchange upgrade.
