Project Description/Justification:

The Department of Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) manages the Bryant Army Airfield (BAF) located on the Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson within the Municipality of Anchorage. BAF not only serves the Army National Guard, it is an alternate airstrip for emergency landings in the area. The Bryant Army Aviation Airfield complex is vital to the mission of the Alaska National Guard and our state relies heavily on the availability of aviation assets.

This request is for eight 100% federally funded deferred maintenance projects at the Bryant Airfield. Priorities and cost estimates may need to be changed to accommodate emergency maintenance projects not listed, actual project costs, and other considerations.
