This is a new deferred maintenance project.

Project Description/Justification:

Funding is requested for roof replacement at the Nome Armory. The Armory roof has outlived its useful life. Temporary patches are currently being applied but active leaks are causing damage to the interior of the facility. This project involves a complete replacement of the current roof. The benefits of a new roof include protection of structure, extended life of the facility, added insulation to the roof, and increased energy efficiency. Priorities and cost estimates may need to be changed to accommodate emergency maintenance projects not listed, actual project costs, and other considerations.
