Add a new attorney to the Barrow District Attorney's office to handle increased workload in this district (PCN 03-#025).

The case loads in the District Attorneys' Offices run from a low in Bethel of 180 per attorney, to a high in Kotzebue of 844, and Barrow of 807. The mean case load is 332. Only four out of the 13 offices are below the mean. Barrow has one attorney and the North Slope Borough has proposed that they provide the State the funds necessary to hire an additional attorney. The addition of a second attorney would reduce the caseload to 403 cases per attorney, 71 above the mean caseload.

\$210,000 in statutory designated program receipts authority is needed to receive funding from the North Slope Borough to cover the costs of a second attorney to serve the Second Judicial District.

This increase was not considered in the FY2012 Governor's Budget submitted December 15, 2010, because the North Slope Borough had not yet extended their offer of funding for this additional position.

This project maintains a critical component of the Disability Justice Focus Area by providing foundational knowledge on mental health disorders and cognitive impairments, best-practice and available treatment, and our state's community behavioral health system. These professionals typically have little or no training in these areas, yet a significant percentage of individuals they interact with professionally experience mental health disorders and/or cognitive impairments. By providing this training, these professionals are better equipped to understand the needs of Trust beneficiaries, consider underlying causes for a beneficiary's contact with the criminal justice system, and to set appropriate conditions of bail/probation given the individuals mental and/or cognitive capacity. This will minimize the risk of future costs associated with incarceration and the processing of another criminal case as a result of bail/probation violations.

Last session, the Governor's Office suggested that there be an increase in the number of investigators in the Medicaid Fraud Unit. This would be a good investment of state funds both because the federal government pays 75% of the cost for these positions and because the amount of fines and restitution this unit obtains is generally larger than any other unit of the criminal division. Presently there are three Investigator III positions and a Forensic Accountant IV. This request is for two additional Investigator IIIs (PCNs 03-#020, -#021) and one Investigator IV (PCN 03-#022). The Investigator IV would supervise the other investigators.

The unit's investigators perform high level investigations of medical professional service providers who are suspected or known to have committed Medicaid fraud, patient abuse or misappropriation of patient assets. They locate and gather information, evidence and/or testimony to be used in litigation and administrative actions, to detect/verify suspected violation of state law, fraud, licensing violations and the like.

This increase was reconsidered after the FY2012 Governor's Budget submitted December 15, 2010, given the projected return on the State's investment.

There are currently 263 open child protection cases in the Mat-Su area. Last year at this time there were approximately 204 open cases. There are currently two attorneys in Palmer assigned to handle the caseload. As a general matter, the Palmer cases tend to go to some form of a contested hearing, often multiple times. In order to address the burgeoning caseload and the overload on the Palmer attorneys, two Anchorage attorneys will start taking some of the cases. The Anchorage attorneys will need to travel to Palmer multiple times during the month to handle the cases, which increases costs (primarily travel), decreases effectiveness and makes it difficult to talk to witnesses. The current caseload exceeds guidelines for effective representation. Federal guidelines recommend a maximum of 100 cases per child protection attorney. Our statewide average is 127 per attorney. Each Palmer attorney currently averages 195 cases. Insufficient paralegal support is also a problem. Many paralegal responsibilities already need to be covered out of the Anchorage office, such as discovery and some trial preparation. For over a year, an Anchorage law office assistant has been going to Palmer at least one day a week to help out.

There is a dispute between Alaska and the tobacco companies that signed the Master Settlement Agreement (MSA) over whether or not Alaska should be subject to the 2003 Non-Participating Manufacturer Adjustment (2003 NPM Dispute). This dispute is expected to be resolved by an arbitration panel. If Alaska is found subject to the 2003 NPM Adjustment, future MSA payments that the state receives could be reduced by up to \$21.0 million to pay off Alaska's portion of this payment adjustment (non-exempt states share the loss jointly). It now appears likely the State will need to continue into FY 2012 its legal efforts to ensure Alaska continues to receive these payments.												
Because this is the first arbitration to take up this issue since execution of the MSA, and because department staff will need to travel to negotiate the procedures agreement and attend the arbitration, there will be significant preparation and travel costs associated with this arbitration.
