The positions will be located in Wasilla, Fairbanks, and Soldotna. Temporarily, all additional personal services authority associated with this project will be recorded in the lump sum premium pay amount. In FY2011, the department received funding for three new state troopers to increase investigations related to domestic violence and sexual assault. These positions were assigned to Anchorage. The Division of Alaska State Troopers (AST) believes that these state trooper positions will be more effective in Bethel, Palmer, and Fairbanks where AST provides primary response to domestic violence and sexual assault calls and where follow up investigation is necessary. In addition, follow up investigators need to work closely with the district attorneys' offices in these regions responsible for prosecuting these cases. For these reasons, this change record requests approval for these duty station changes.

The positions that are being transferred include State Trooper PCN 12-?070 Bethel, PCN 12-?076 Palmer, and PCN 12-?077 Fairbanks. The increased cost for this location change of \$34.4 can be absorbed within the current fiscal year's budget due to the delay in getting the positions established through the personnel system. In FY2012, a line item adjustment will be requested.

The Department of Public Safety, Division of Alaska State Troopers, requests funding to allow the division to increase state trooper presence in rural Alaska. These troopers will investigate crimes, respond to domestic violence and sexual assaults, assist with search and rescues, transport prisoners, and provide proactive enforcement such as community policing.

One new post will be established in either Kiana or Selawik to cover the villages of Kiana, Selawik, Noorvik, and Ambler. The final decision will be made with input from the leadership in the region. The cost of establishing the post will be the same in either case.

The post will be staffed by two state troopers who will alternate two weeks on and two weeks off. While on duty, each trooper will be available 14 days in a row, 12 hours per day. This increment will add a program coordinator II position to the council staff. The program coordinator will coordinate prevention projects funded through the council at the community, regional and statewide levels; provide technical assistance on prevention programming to funded programs; interact with counterparts in governmental and non-governmental agencies; and apply for and manage federal prevention grants. We anticipate the increased emphasis on preventing domestic violence and sexual assault will steadily increase over the life of the governor's initiative and need a subject matter expert to adequately handle the new demands such focused attention will bring.

Emphasis on preventing domestic and sexual violence escalated this year, increasing the workload of the current program coordinators. In addition to administering federal grants, providing technical assistance and monitoring victim service and approved batterers intervention programs, convening statewide stakeholder groups, participating in the Anchorage Fatality Review Team, the Fairbanks Supervised Visitation Project, and various committees of the Governor's Domestic Violence/Sexual Assault initiative, the office has been assigned responsibilities associated with statewide prevention efforts.

Edgecumbe High School by coordinating with school administrative staff on scheduling, keeping the school abreast of student progress, making sure waivers and consents are in place, as well as other similar duties as necessary.
