**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

This is a new capital request because of a STIP amendment that occurred after the December 15 release of the Governor's FY2012 budget. This project aims to relocate a portion of Champion Road to avoid erosion of approximately two miles of road that is threatened by the Yukon River. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.

**Project Description/Justification:**

Champion Road provides access to the Federal Aviation Administration air navigation facilities and the Galena landfill. The Yukon River erosion has accelerated and is threatening the roadway. Champion Road at Beaver Creek has serious drainage problems, two of the three large diameter culverts are no longer functional.
