Emergency federal funds are available from the Federal Highway Administration for declared emergencies. Money spent within 180 days of a declared emergency are funded at 100% federal; after the 180th day, about 9% state match is required. This appropriation may be used to address issues of an emergency nature with federal airport or highway formula funds. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by reducing injuries, fatalities and property damage and by improving the mobility of people and goods.
