Project Description/Justification:

The preconstruction stage of a surface transportation improvement project may include any or all of the following: reconnaissance, preliminary engineering, design, right-of-way acquisition and utilities relocation activities necessary to prepare all of the documents, maps and plans and obtain all permits for project construction, or to provide engineering support for federally required programs such as Bridge Management System or Safety Management System. These funds are used for those projects in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS) Transportation Improvement Program and the Fairbanks Metropolitan Area Transportation System (FMATS) Transportation Improvement Program. Only right-of-way acquisition and utilities relocation less than \$750,000 per project are included in this request. Right-of-way acquisition and utilities relocation greater than \$750,000 are requested individually.
