Project Description/Justification:

This road is the only link from the Bethel Airport to the core residential area of town. Current road surface conditions on this portion of the Bethel core area road network are poor with rutting and potholes prevalent. The lack of surfacing material, along with inadequate road base stability, impedes traffic flow and damages vehicles. The road is heavily used for both commercial and residential traffic.

This request reflects a revised engineer's estimate for construction costs and right-of-way acquisition.

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
