This is a new FY2012 request that is needed for the project to be put out for bid. This project is being included in the FY2012 amended request due to changes in the scheduled obligation of federal funds to other DOT&PF projects that occurred after the release of the budget on December 15, 2010. This project will widen the New Seward Highway from four to six lanes from Tudor to Dowling Roads, and provide improvements for both frontage roads (Homer and Brayton Drives) to include multi-use trails, replace 5 bridges and construct an interchange at International Airport Road.
