Project Description/Justification:

The Airport Master Plan identifies the need to expand the safety area. Suitable material from obstruction removal will be used to expand the safety areas up to the recommended 500' wide for runway 9/27. Consideration of coastal erosion and boating channels is required to avoid undo community impacts. Improved runway safety areas would result in significant improvements in safety due to runway overruns.

The first construction stage rehabilitated the runway and lighting, and the second stage will pave the taxiway and repair the apron.
