Project Description/Justification:

Potter Road provides an important connection between Rosie Creek Road and Cripple Creek Road in a growing residential area. The gravel surface on Potter Road is seriously degraded, resulting in high maintenance costs, unsafe lane usage/weaving, and slowed emergency vehicle response. The Chena Goldstream Volunteer Fire Department Station #4 is located on Potter Road.
