Raise the grade, replace the Mukluk Creek Bridge #1382, and resurface the lower portion of the airport access road (approximately 1,500 feet). **Project Description/Justification:**

The road is rutted and soft in wet weather making it difficult to access the airport. During spring break up, the airport is inaccessible due to frequent flooding. This prevents the delivery of freight and fuel from the airport to the community store, health clinic, post office, and fuel holding areas. The existing bridge is load restricted and narrow. If the bridge is flooded the airport cannot be accessed by DOT&PF maintenance crews.
