Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

This is a new capital request because of a STIP amendment that occurred after the December 15 release of the Governor's FY2012 budget. This work will consist of an update to all of the state's transition plans for public rights of way (ROW), which includes pedestrian facilities. These transition plans are more 16 years old and are no longer useful for ADA efforts. The work will consist of a determination that the facilities are compliant or noncompliant. If the facilities are found to noncompliant, then it will be determined if the correction to compliance is readily achievable, technically feasible or technically infeasible when the ROW is next altered or reconstructed.
