## **Project Description/Justification:**

A recent conditions assessment report identified significant improvements required to rehabilitate the Douglas Island facility to acceptable standards and to add another 20+ years of life to the building. The primary improvements include replacement of 25,000 s.f. of exterior curtain wall and replacement of failing concrete steps and landings.
