Detailed Project Description and Justification:

These funds will be used to continue a dust control program in the greater Seldovia region on unpaved roads. The City has been providing this service with a combination of state and local funds since 2005. Prior to that, the Department of Transportation supplied the material.

The dust created from traffic on the unpaved roads creates a health hazard to those living and traveling nearby. Tourists and local residents often walk, jog, and bike along these main roads as there aren't any other options in the area.

The City of Seldovia has recently purchased a spreader that will allow us to apply the material on the narrower sections of road. The city will ask the state DOT department to help with spreading the material along Jakolof Bay Road.

Project Timeline:

The project will begin as early as weather permits in FY13.
