This project will upgrade a major local road to urban standards. Improvements are expected to include a new road base, curbs, pavement, storm drainage, pedestrian facilities, and landscaping.

Project funding is proposed as a partnership of local road bonds and state grants. State grant funding is proposed for design. This is a strip paved road with inadequate drainage, pedestrian, and lighting facilities. The vertical slopes and no shoulders on this narrow road create negatively impact safety.

The grant funding may be used for utility work, obtaining rights of way and easements, and any work associated with upgrading the roadway and its amenities.

Design expenditures are anticipated in 2013-2016.
