This project will construct pedestrian safety improvements to this intersection. The exact improvements will be determined in the design phase.

Design was funded with a 2010 state grant. Construction funding is proposed in 2012 with a state grant. Design is underway. Historically, this intersection is ranked the 14th most dangerous in Anchorage for pedestrian/bicycle crashes. This project is ranked number 9 out of 319 in the Anchorage Pedestrian Plan.

The grant funding may be used for utility work, obtaining rights of way and easements, and any work associated with the improvements described above or associated amenities.

**Project Timeline:**

Construction expenditures are anticipated in 2013 and 2014.
