Brief Project Description:

The Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Department seeks to upgrade the electrical system in the Tri-Valley Community Center which holds the fire station, Denali Borough government offices, a local bank, health clinic and the local community center.

\$25,000 in local funds for a structural survey of the building.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Tri-Valley Community Center has been owned, operated and maintained by the Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Department for 30 years. The community center houses the local Alaska State Troopers detachment, Denali Borough Administration, Interior Neighborhood Health Clinic, First National Bank of Alaska and the Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Department. It also serves as the main emergency shelter in the area and is equipped with a full kitchen.

This upgrade will solve a number of ongoing problems with the electrical system of the community center.

1. The elevator control unit has been unreliable for a number of years. We have had many instances of people getting trapped in the elevator due to a malfunction of the controls. We also use the elevator to bring emergency patients to the Clinic that is located on the second floor of the center. We have spent thousands of dollars to keep the elevator operating, but have been told that further repairs will require the replacement of the control unit. Replacing the unit will require 3 phase power, which is unavailable in the building.
