Detailed Project Description and Justification:

In accordance with its apparatus replacement schedule, the fire department replaces one fire engine each year. The Engine Company is the most common apparatus in the fleet and carries a fire pump, water tank, and fire hose. It responds to all types of emergencies including fires and medical emergencies. Engine Companies typically have a lifespan of 15 years or 150,000 miles. The Municipality is requesting funding to replace one Engine Company, to include all tools, equipment and fire hose needed to supply the apparatus.

Project Timeline:

It is the fire department's intention to purchase this apparatus at the end of FY 2012 and receive delivery approximately 12 months later.
