Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Alaska High School Hall of Fame was established to identify and honor, in a permanent manner, individuals who exhibited high ethical standards and integrity while achieving excellence in high school athletics and activities, as well as others who have distinguished themselves by virtue of exemplary contributions to the advancement of interscholastic athletics and activities in the State of Alaska.

While the guidelines, awards ceremonies and selection committee parameters have been established, the AHSOF has not been able to establish a public display of the inductees or attract sponsorship to provide ongoing support.

Funds are requested to support the effort to establish a presence and create an important long lasting home for the AHSOF. Because ASAA state activities cover a wide range of events, it is proposed to create a mobile display that could be set up at major state events. The ability to have a display available would create an opportunity for sponsor recognition, inform the public of the AHSOF and provide a venue to encourage additional nominations, plus honor those who have been inducted.
