Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Nushagak Electric & Telephone Cooperative Inc, (NETC) has completed a 5 year review with ADEC, and due to the lack of storage capacity in Dillingham for contaminated fuel from a possible catastrophic failure of a bulk fuel tank.

NETC after looking at all possible options, assigned its 500,000 gallon fuel tank for Emergency use only to meet the requirements of the new spill plan.

NETC no longer has enough fuel storage capacity to cover one year of fuel for the power generation requirements of our service area. This creates a need to receive two fuel shipments per year. One in the spring and one in the fall. This is a huge challenge to meet this requirement due to ice, weather, barg availability, and scheduling.

We are requesting this funding to build an additional 850,000 gallon fuel storage tank which will assist us in accommodating our need to meet reliable power generation for our community.
