The Birch Creek Tribal Council has obligated a portion of their FY 2011 Indian Housing Block Grant funds towards this project.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Commencing on May 26, 2011, the village of Birch Creek sustained severe losses and threats to life, property, and public health resulting from a devastating fire which consumed the tribal office, generator building, telephone building and community watering point. The Govenor declared a disaster emergency and provided disaster assistance in response and recovery from this event for all affected buildings EXCEPT for the tribal office.

Birch Creek does not have a tribal office in their community making it very difficult and often times impossible to conduct day to day operations. The Tribe recieved approval from the Yukon Flats School District to relocate the community watering system to the old school building and appropriate repair measures were taken to accomodate such a system in the building. The building is deemed sound and solid. The Tribe would now like to use force account labor to further rehab the building to accomate a tribal office. A budget of \$120,000 has been prepared.

This is the communities number one priority.
