### **Brief Project Description:**

Acquisition of two mini-trucks to serve the solid waste operation and environmental program in Igiugig, Alaska.

#### *Funding Details:*

*\$5,000 cash contribution has been secured by the Igiugig Village Council in FY12 to dedicate to this project.*

### **Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

Currently Igiugig operates a Class III Landfill and extensive recycling center that backhauls batteries, plastics, and aluminum. We also separate and crush glass, and re-use paper/cardboard products. Food scraps are also kept separately and used to feed the local chickens or compost pile. Our dumpster is also located in downtown Igiugig for easy access by residents. We do not have a vehicle to operate any of the landfill or recycling transfers; in fact, the entire operation depends on personal and commercial vehicles to manage the solid waste facility and environmental program/greenhouse. The goal of this project is to acquire two mini-trucks to handle and process the amount of waste and recyclables in this community so that the program no longer uses personal and commercial vehicles. Insurance for the drivers, and the mini-truck maintenance, will be the responsibility of Igiugig Village Council. This is a one-time cost.

### **Project Timeline:**

July 2012: Purchase mini-trucks

September 2012: Ship to Igiugig

October 2012: Mini-trucks will be deployed to serve the solid waste and environmental program. Their ongoing maintenance and insurance for drivers will be the responsibility of the Igiugig Village Council.
