Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The North Star Council on Aging Senior Center has debt incurred due to unexpected vehicle expenses repairs, facility repairs, and administrative costs associated with high turnover at the BOD and staff level. Outstanding debt to date is around \$145,000 while daily operational expenses continue to incur. The Nutrition and Transportation Services Grant (NTS) is expected to continue, at the start of the fiscal year July 1 and is not secured now.

The Senior Center provides meals to seniors in both congregate and in-home setting often referred to as "Meals on Wheels". We also offer transportation services for those seniors who are not homebound to eat in a congregate setting and socialize. In addition to this we also offer information and referral services to seniors regarding other nonprofits in the area.

Project Timeline:

If funded, the North Star Council on Aging will immediately pay off financial obligations, and begin to revitalize these essential services for seniors through the Nutrition and Transportation Services, the main grant for the agency.
