Detailed Project Description and Justification:

This project removes and replaces 38 aging, leaking windows in Building A of the Community Mental Health Center Outpatient Clinic. The clinic is consistently cold in the winter and requires excessive amounts of heating oil to try to maintain acceptable temperature for clients and staff. Clients have complained for years about the cold in JAMHI building, negatively impacting the therapeutic environment. Replacement windows would be energy efficient and save on costly fuel to reduce overall operating expenses.

Project includes removal of all windows in 2-story building, installation of 38 PLYGEM double pane windows with screens, inside and outside trim, and haul all debris to landfill. Remove sliding glass door on back side of building and frame in for new window.
