Risks and impacts from new spills will be reduced around the state (in Arctic and non-Arctic locations) by: developing additional geographic response strategies with detailed nearshore response plans to protect critical environmentally sensitive areas from oil spills; purchasing additional emergency towing systems to provide an emergency response capability for vessels in distress; developing potential places of refuge for vessel casualties and maintaining the statewide hazmat response capabilities. The Department last received funding for first responder equipment in the FY2010 budget which primarily focused on non-Arctic areas.
