**Project Description/Justification:**

The project will improve the highway to accommodate increased traffic volumes and provide a safe highway with an acceptable 20-year Level of Service. The new facility will have partial control of access. Partial control provides median breaks at important intersections, but minimize driveway access. In addition, a frontage road is proposed for the west side of the highway between Cienna Avenue and South Colony Way.
