**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

Annual funding to meet Lake Hood (LHD) Seaplane Base needs for projects that arise during the year. Used to make improvements and correct minor deficiencies and solve problems created by unforeseen circumstances at the Airport. Examples include projects to address deterioration, failures or damage to existing facilities, obsolete facilities, new needs, and changed operational, Transportation Security Administration (TSA), and Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) requirements.

Resolve minor deficiencies and solve problems created by unforeseen circumstances for both the Airport and users.

The airport receives \$1,000,000 in entitlements each year. Projects are needed on an annual basis and these funds need to be available to undertake those projects.
