Project Description/Justification:

Yandukin and Shell Simmons Drive provides the primary access to Juneau International Airport. The pavement on Yandukin Drive/Shell Simmons Drive has pot holes and sections of failing pavement. Airport access has become a maintenance burden. There is significant pedestrian traffic generated by Juneau International Airport however pedestrian facilities are inadequate. This project will rehabilitate the pavement, reduce the cost of annual maintenance and provide adequate pedestrian facilities. The project is needed to maintain the integrity and safety of access to the airport.
