Project Description/Justification:

Upgrade existing airport owned water, sewer, natural gas, and communications on the Kulis property to bring them up to utility company standards (AWWU, Enstar, ACS/GCI). This will allow them to be turned over to the utilities for ownership and maintenance. Construct a new Air Operations Area (AOA) security fence with access control around the aircraft apron area to enable it to be used for aircraft operations. Improve control and operation of existing access gates. Pave miscellaneous areas where buildings were removed. Construct an Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) Vehicle Access Road from the Kulis Fire Station North to the tug road parallel to and south of Runway 7R/25L. The current access from the Fire Station to the airfield is through the existing Kulis aircraft parking aprons. Use of the Kulis Fire Station will improve our ARFF response time and make us better able to fulfill our Part 139 requirements.
