**Project Description/Justification:**

This segment of Nordic Drive is a minor arterial providing access to the ferry terminal. The pavement has reached the end of its service life. Sections of pavement have failed and become a maintenance burden. Rehabilitation of the pavement will reduce maintenance expense, improve operational safety and extend the life of the paved roadway. The curb and sidewalks along this segment of Nordic Drive do not meet the American Disability Act (ADA) requirements. Safety for motorists and non-motorized users will be improved by construction of this project.
