This is a new FY2013 capital project due to the submission and approval of the new 2012 - 2015 Statewide Transportation Improvements Program (STIP), which occurred after the December 15th release of the Governor's budget. The implementation of the '6004 Program' authorized by SAFETEA-LU authorized the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF) to approve environmental documents meeting certain criterion. This program has greatly expedited the approval of environmental documents and increased the quality of documentation from those previously approved by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).
