It incorporates information from previous years' building surveys at the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT/PF) buildings, including the Ft. Yukon and Anchorage Boney Courthouses, and adds recent issues arising at Sitka, Boney, and Fairbanks. Additionally, this project list includes deferred maintenance work at the court owned/managed facilities which prior to FY2012 were included in a separate request "Building Equipment and Systems Replacement" at several locations, including Ft. Yukon, Delta Junction, Sitka, Juneau and Seward.

This project covers only those deficiencies not previously funded and not requested by DOT/PF or the Department of Administration. Annual funding amounts are determined according to the urgency associated with building failure or safety; e.g., roof failure can result in failure of many other structural components or worn flooring presents a trip/fall liability.
