Funding Details:

A 2010 state grant funded initial design efforts and some improvements. Local bond fundings is programmed for FY 2016.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

This project will construct pedestrian improvements in the Nunaka Valley Subdivision in the vicinity of Nunaka Valley Elementary School.

Design was funded with a state grant. Construction funding is proposed with a combination of state grants and local road bonds. Upgrades to pedestrian facilities are needed in the area around Nunaka Valley Elementary School. Most of the children at the school walk in the roadway each day.

The grant funding may be used for planning, design, utility work, obtaining rights of way and easements, construction, and any work associated with the improvements described above or associated amenities.

Project Timeline:

Design expenditures will occur in 2014 and 2015. Construction expense is anticipated in 2015 and 2016.
