There is a residential subdivision in Elim which is not protected by a fire response system. In the event of a fire, local response crews do not have access to a fire hydrant in order to combat a fire in this area. All the other subdivisions in town have access to hydrants and the community fire response system is structured to use hydrants in the event of a fire. Thus, there is no other means of fire response available to the community. This severely impairs the community's ability to contain a fire in this subdivision and exposes its residents to loss of life and property. Moreover, an uncontained fire incident in this subdivision has the potential of growing into a fire which could threaten the entire community. This project proposes to extend the existing hydrant system in order to serve this subdivision and mitigate the risk posed by fire.
